

### SEDATION

- The sedation you received for your procedure is still in your system. Therefore, we would like you to take it easy the rest of the day (do not drive and avoid drinking alcohol).

### ACTIVITY

- You may resume your regular activities, including driving in 24 hours. Unless you have been restricted for another reason.
- No exercising, lifting heavy objects, or strenuous activity for the next 24 hours.
- You may shower the following day.

### PAIN MANAGEMENT

- You may use over the counter medications such as Tylenol or Advil for minor discomfort, if you are not otherwise restricted from these medications.

### CARE OF YOUR BIOPSY SITE

(Check One) liver pancreas kidney other

- You will have a small bandage over the site.
- You may remove the bandage the following day. Keep site dry and clean. No new bandage is needed.

### WHEN TO CALL YOUR PHYSICIAN

- Fever and Chills
- Severe pain
- Bleeding, redness or swelling at procedure site.
- Unable to urinate.
- Shortness of breath.
